



Instructions for Uploading Freezemark and Microchip Information for your own Horses

Step 1

You need to be a current member of NED to associate yourself with your own equines and add any additional information about them.

- If you are not a registered user of NED then click "Register" in the top left hand corner of your screen and follow the instructions.
- If you have registered with NED but not yet become a member ensure you are logged in then click "MyNED" and follow the instructions to apply for membership.
- If you are already a member simply login and proceed to Step 2.

Step 2

Once your membership is set up, find your freezemarked or microchipped horse by using the Search option, select your horse from any searches returned and associate with this horse by clicking on "Associate yourself with this equine".

If you are already associated with your horse click on "myHorses" to find it.

Step 3

Once you have associated with a horse, click "Edit" to go to the Owner's Information section and click on "Identification Information" to upload your microchip or freezemark information. Make sure that you have the correct numbers to hand first and re-check them carefully before you save the details.

In some cases, we have received freezemark and microchip information direct from the Passport Issuing Organisations, but in many cases, we have not. Adding this information yourself will enable NED to help you to trace stolen horses or horses missing on loan.
